6. B.A. in English	40	Bachelor's Degree in any discipline having English as a compulsory subject (Hons./ Pass/General) with a minimum of 80% marks for General / OBC candidates and 85% marks for SC/ST / PWD category candidates from any recognized University.		
7. B.A. in Hindi	40	Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from any recognized University with a minimum of 80% marks for General / OBC candidates and 85% marks for SC/ST / PWD candidates.		
8. B.A. in Sociology	40	Bachelor's Degree in any subject from any recognized University with a minimum of 80% marks for General / OBC candidates and 85% marks for SC/ST / PWD candidates.
