1. An applicant can apply for payment through net-banking/debit/credit card/UPI.
2. GST and other taxes as applicable by Govt. of India/ Bank.
3. An applicant can apply for three programmes from three Participating Universities (PUs) by paying application fee as mentioned above.
4. An applicant can further apply upto 03 additional PU's (03 programmes each) by availing Add-on facility by paying additional fee as Rs. 800/- (Gen/OBC/EWS applicants) or Rs. 350/- (SC/ST applicants) for UI & PG Programmes and Rs. 1000/- (Gen/OBC/EWS applicants) or Rs. 450/- (SC/ST applicants) for RP Programmes.
