Hence, applicants will themselves be responsible if they opt for a programme for which they are not eligible.
- Applications should be submitted ONLINE only; OFFLINE applications will NOT be accepted.
- Applicants are required to have a valid personal email ID and mobile number which should be kept active during the entire admission process, so that the university may send alerts, important communications etc., regarding entrance test. Under no circumstances, the candidate shall transmit his/her email ID with any other person as all communication will be made through e-mail and SMS. Please ensure that SMS (Do Not Disturb) is not activated on your mobile.
