

Regulations for the Award of 'Scholarship to Deaf Students'

1. **Premise :** The University envisages its whole time Deaf students especially those below or to economically weaker sections of the society to carry on their studies by offering them types of financial assistance in the form of scholarship basis, in which they may meet their extra expenses on transport.

2. **Eligibility :**

(i) The Scholarship shall be admissible to the whole time Deaf students of the University especially those belonging to economically weaker sections or meet additional transport expenses. Students with 40% or more disability and the parents annual gross income from all sources not exceeding Rs. 1,20,000/- shall be eligible for the scholarship.

(ii) The assistance would be admissible from the date of commencement of the semester or admission of the student in the semester, whichever is later, on the date of consideration of the request. The assistance would be admissible based on the medical certificate issued by the competent medical authority in the University. Scholarships will be given to different categories of disabled students as under:

- (a) Students with orthopedic disability
- (b) Students with visual impairment
- (c) Students with hearing disability
- (d) Students with Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation, Multiple Disabilities, profound or severe learning impairment etc.
