Notice for passing out Batch Students of UG/PG Programs

This has reference to the semester calendar for the students admitted in academic year 2019 & before issued vide F.No. CUSB/Acad/6-4/2013/15 dated 05.01.2021.

- 2. In pursuance of the above referred semester calendar, the end term examination of 4th semester (PG), 8th Semester (BA/B.Sc.-B.Ed) & 2nd Semester (PG Diploma in Yoga) in OBE mode alongwith viva-voce has been conducted and completed.
- 3. It is to be noted that the practical component and laboratory work of the previous & last Semesters could not be conducted due to covid-19 pandemic & ensuing lockdown declared from time to time by the Government of India.
- 4. It has been decided by the UATEC in its 29th meeting held on 06.07.2021 to open the University in lines with the Government of Bihar guidelines (Kkikad -जी/आपदा -06-02/2020-3646 पटना, दिनांक- 05 जुलाई, 2021) in order to provide laboratory exposure to the students and complete their practical classes including Continuous Internal Assessment of practical component between 15th -31st July 2021.
- 5. Students of the following programs have to compulsory be present to attend such practical classes as per the schedule to be notified by their respective departmental heads; hence students are instructed to plan their journey accordingly.
 - BSc. BEd 8th Semester.
 - PG Yoga 2nd Semester.
 - (iii) M.Sc. Physics- 4th Semester
- (iv) M.Sc. Chemistry -4th Semester
 (v) M.Sc. Life Science- 4th Semester
- (vi) MA. Journalism & Mass Communication - 4th Semester
- 6. Final Semester result of these programs will be only declared after the receipt of Continuous Internal Assessment based on practical work done by the students.
- 7. In view of the SOP as detailed in UGC guidelines dated 05.11.2020, considering the safety of each student and in order to ensure social distancing the University will provide hostel facility to the desirous students.
- 8. Such desirous students may be provided single seated hostel room facility only after they compulsorily register themselves on https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSfZhKNBETYn6BRJVEu5rXMbd yD5 cjmTDoYY1JSK2UHhHQl2Q/viewform?usp=pp url > latest by 13th July 2021.

- 9. They will be required to pay a fixed charge of Rs. 2000/- for accommodation in the hostel through SBI e-collect. Additionally, payment for mess facility will have to be paid @ Rs. 87/- per day in cash to the hostel warden depending on the duration of their stay.
- 10. No student shall be provided hostel accommodation if she/he does not register for it.
- 11. The rooms will be allotted one day before the commencement of their practical classes and must be vacated within 24 hours after completion of their practical work.
- 12. Students must compulsorily carry either their Vaccination Certificate or RT-PCR negative report (if infected).
- 13. Students must submit a consent form from their parents (Proforma attached).
