

Purpose

Whereas, it is mandatory, and undeniably necessary to evaluate only those students who have not adopted any other means being the examination;

Whereas, this is desirable as well as morally accepted principles of the examination system proper use of other means;

Whereas, it is necessary to lay down the guidelines for the promotion of use of other means;

Whereas candidates are required to know acts and deeds;

1. Short Title, Application and Commencement

- (a) These regulations may be called **CUBB Regulations Relating to Promotion, Exemption and Re-examination Concerning Use of Other Means in the Examinations, 2020**;
- (b) These regulations shall be applicable to every examination of the university;
- (c) These regulations shall come into force with effect from the date of their approval by the competent authority of the university;
- (d) All the Departments and the Colleges shall be bound to apply these regulations, subject to any specific provisions given for any individual reasons or in conformity with the requirements/ compliance with Regulatory Body functions;

2. Interpretation Clause

- (a) 'Candidate' means all the students enrolled with the faculty/ university of South Africa to pursue any Programme offered by the any Department/College of the university;
- (b) 'Examination' means any reference that Semester, Mid Term, Final Term, Viva Voce and Practical Examination etc;
- (c) 'Regulatory Bodies' means and includes UDE, HEI, NCTE, BCI and BCI etc;
- (d) 'University' means the faculty/ university of South Africa, India;
- (e) 'Programme' means the entire course of study and examinations;
- (f) 'Semester' means a term consisting of seven (7) months;
- (g) 'Whereas' the word 'Whereas' is a part of a subject matter to be covered in a
