

Regulations for the Award of Merit cum Merit Scholarship

- 1. Purpose:** Merit cum Merit Scholarship shall be awarded in recognition of any other scholarship such as the CSR for the students in all programmes of the University, strictly on merit-cum-income basis and on the recommendation of the Scholarship Cell. A maximum of 20% of the students in each programme will be considered for this scholarship.

- 2. Eligibility:**

(a) Merit Criteria: All the eligible students of the University, may apply for this scholarship. For U^g semester students, the performance in the admission entrance/Interviews shall be considered for determining their merit. However, a 60% of cut is mandatory for the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th semester students, as the case may be.

The scholarship will be awarded on a semester basis provided the student fulfils all the terms and conditions for renewal of the scholarship. The parental income of student and 60% of it will be the criteria of scholarship.

(b) Income Criteria: The parents annual gross income from all sources should not exceed Rs. 1,00,000/- . Student applying for the scholarship must submit a valid income certificate issued by competent revenue authority for the preceding year alongwith the application form. No fresh income certificate
