Agenda No.01/UATEC-13/18

To Report the approval of Minutes of 12th Meeting of the

UATEC held on 15.02.2018 by the Academic Council.

Resolution No.01/UATEC-13/18:

The Chairperson reported that the minutes of the 11th & 12th meeting of UATEC held on 24/01/2018 & 15/02/2018 respectively was approved by the Academic Council in its 16th meeting held on 14/03/2018. The members were requested to take a note of it.

Agenda No.02/UATEC-13/18

To apprise about conduct of Central Universities Common Entrance Test - 2018, result declaration and modalities of Online counselling as apprised in the meeting on 25/05/2018 at Central University of Rajasthan.

Resolution No.02/UATEC-13/18:

The Controller of Examinations briefed the members about CUCET-2018 held on 28-29 April, 2018. She informed that altogether 13,385 candidates appeared in CUCET-2018 at ten examination centres under control of CUSB. The result of CUCET-2018 has been announced on 25th May, 2018 and the score-list of the candidates appeared for the programmes offered by Central University of South Bihar, has been provided by Central University of Rajasthan.

She further informed that due to lack of clarity in the steps to be taken for common online counselling, the University has decided to opt out of the same and go for offline counselling this year.

To decide the ratio of the candidates to be called for counselling/admission in different UG/PG Programmes and programme wise cut off marks for 1st merit list on the basis of the CUCET-2018 score list vis-a-vis the reservation guidelines of Govt. of India.
