

To apprise about first & second round of admissions and status of vacant seats.

Resolution No.01/UATEC-14/17

The Member Secretary apprised the members that out of the total 1008 intake of seats for 26 UG and PG programmes and inspite of conducting two round of admission process in 13 programmes, the total number of seats filled is 536 (approx. 53%) & vacant seats is 472 (approx. 47%). To consider the modalities of filling of the vacant seats in the last round of the counselling cum admission process.

Resolution No.02/UATEC-14/17

The Members were apprised about the 1st and 2nd round of counselling and the efforts taken by the COE office to contact all prospective students by email and by sending SMS to inform them about their status in the cut off list and dates of admission. The University in its second round of counselling has given opportunity to students who had appeared for the CUCET-2018 examination of the concerned subject and even though had not opted for CUSB while locking the preference. The Secretary also apprised the members that the students studying in the state Universities of Bihar were not given admission in the first and second round because they had still not appeared in the final year examination. Such students were in large numbers and requested for granting admission as it was due to no fault of theirs that they would lose a year if not granted admission. They were assured that the matter would be considered at the appropriate level since it is the responsibility of their respective University to conduct Examination on time. The issues were discussed in detail and the committee resolved the following –

- 1. The students who could not appear in the 1st and 2nd round of counselling be also given an opportunity in the last round of admission.
- 2. Students who had not opted for CUSB while filling the CUCET-2018 form but have appeared in the concerned examination may be given a chance to take admission, if they fall in the merit list.
- 3. Candidates of other Universities who have appeared / will be appearing in the final year examination and results of which are expected to be declared by September 30, 2018 should be considered for admissions.
- 4. Wherein seats fall vacant in a particular category and there are candidates available in the waiting list either from the first or second round, they should be first given the opportunity to take admission.
- 5. For filling seats of M.Tech (Computer Science) it was decided to open the same for all candidates having valid GATE score irrespective of the fact that they have either appeared for CUCET or registered for CCMT counselling or not.
- 6. It was also resolved that all admission process for Academic Year 2018-19 will be closed on 1st August 2018.

To consider the conduct of mid-term examination as a part of continuous internal assessment for the academic session prior to 2018-19.

Resolution No.03 (i)/UATEC-14/17

The Committee discussed the existing way of conduct of mid-term examination as per semester calendar and it was observed that over the period of time the conduct of mid-term examination has developed to the extent of the end-term despite being a part of continuous internal assessment. Resultantly, the conduct of the mid-term including the mid-semester break occupies 12-15 days during the semester.

The Committee discussed the matter at length and after detailed deliberations, it was resolved to approve that the mid-term examination carrying 15 marks shall be conducted by the respective course teachers in the manner of other continuous internal assessment as per their suitability preferably in the mid of the semester on any working day. Thus, henceforth there would be no mid-semester breaks.
