

An extended meeting of UATEC comprising Heads of all the Departments as special invitee was held on 16.05.2019 in the administrative block under the Chairmanship of Prof. Sankar Kumar Bhaumik, Dean, School of Social Sciences and Policy.

At the outset the Chairperson welcomed all the members of the newly constituted University Admission, Teaching and Evaluation Committee (UATEC) and the special invitees and briefed about the Agenda of the meeting.

After the opening remarks of the Chairperson, the agenda of the meeting was taken up seriatim.

Agenda No.01/UATEC-17/19

To confirm the Minutes of 16th Meeting of the UATEC held on 06.02.2019.

Resolution No. 01/UATEC-17/19

As no observations were received on the Minutes of 16th Meeting of the UATEC held on 06.02.2019, the UATEC resolved to confirm the Minutes of the 16th UATEC meeting.

Agenda No.02/UATEC-17/19

To report Academic Council Resolution No. 15/ AC-18/19 notified vide Ref. CUSB/AC-18/2019 /524 dated 30.04.2019.

Resolution No. 02/UATEC-17/19

The Member Secretary informed that the Academic Council in its 18th meeting held on 05.02.2019 vide Resolution No. 15/AC-18/19 approved the Minutes of the 15th meeting of the UATEC held on 30.10.2018 with amendments in Resolution No. 04/UATEC-15/18 as follows –

"The Academic Council considered the minutes of the meeting of University Admission, Teaching & Evaluation Committee (UATEC) held on 30.10.2018 and **resolved** that the same except Agenda No. 04/UATEC – 15/18 criteria regarding provision for reexamination of backlog courses of Ph.D. Course-Work be approved. The Committee further **resolved** that Resolution No. 04/UATEC – 15/18 be re-framed as under and it be reported to the UATEC in its next meeting.

In accordance with the UGC Regulation 2016 (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.PHIL./PH.D Degrees), It was resolved to complete the Course work prescribed by the Dept. during the initial one or two semesters.

It was further resolved that backlog examination of Ph.D. Course work not cleared in the first semester may be conducted within one month of declaration of result. In case the student fails to clear the backlog, s/he will have to repeat the course work in the second semester.

In case any Course work is being conducted only in the 2^{nd} Semester and the student fails to clear the same, s/he will only have the option to appear at the backlog examination within 01 (one) Month and will not be permitted to repeat the Semester.

Under no circumstances any Ph.D. Scholar will be allowed to continue beyond one year, if s/he fails to clear the Course work her/his registration will be cancelled".

In pursuance of the decision of Academic Council the provision for conduct of backlog examinations of Ph.D. Course Work was notified for implementation vide notification no. F.No. CUSB/AC-18/2019/524 dated 30.04.2019.

The UATEC members discussed about the provision of repeating the course work in case a student fails to clear the backlog. The committee was of the opinion that once a student has completed his/her attendance requirement to appear in the examination of Course Work but fails

to clear the examination or backlog Examination he may appear in the re-Examination without repeating the course work.

After detailed deliberation, the UATEC resolved to recommend to the Academic Council to amend the provision of conduct of backlog examination of Ph.D. Course as under.

"A Ph.D. student shall be required to complete the course work prescribed by the Department during initial one or two semesters. In case the students have minimum 75% attendance and he fails to clear the Course Work in the first semester, the Backlog Examination may be conducted within one month of declaration of Result. If the student fails to clear the Backlog Examination the student shall be required to clear the Course Work Examination before end of Second Semester.

Under no circumstances any Ph.D. Scholar will be allowed to continue beyond one year, if s/he fails to clear the Course work her/his registration will be cancelled".

Subject to the approval of Academic Council the committee resolved to recommend to refer the matter again to the Academic Council and proposed to add the above provision after clause XI.V of Ph.D. Ordinance.

To discuss the M.Tech Computer Science, Session – 2016-18 student's (Rajesh Kumar – CUSB1602322006) application & recommendation of the Departmental Committee meeting regarding submission of M.Tech Computer Science dissertation.

Resolution No. 04/UATEC-17/19

The Member Secretary informed that the dissertation submitted by Rajesh Kumar (Enrolment No. – CUSB1602322006), a student of M.Tech Computer Science Programme, Session -2016-18 was not approved by the Departmental Committee of Department of Computer Science and some modifications was suggested for improvement of dissertation. Accordingly, Rajesh Kumar was communicated to submit the dissertation after incorporating the suggestions and getting it evaluated by the supervisor by 13.07.2018. However no progress was made by Rajesh Kumar in this regard. On 5th February, 2019 Rajesh Kumar has sent an Email citing that he could not submit the revised dissertation in view of his joining as IT Manager in Bihar Prashashnik Sudhar Mission Society and has now sought permission for submission of the same.

The UATEC considered the matter and resolved that before submission of revised dissertation Rajesh Kumar has to first get himselfregistered in Department of Computer Science by depositing the Semester Fee and complete the process of submission of dissertation and viva voce examination as per the Regulations. He shall be required to submit No Objection Certificate from his employer in order to get himself registered.

Resolution No. 06/UATEC-17/19

The member secretary informed that the DRDC of Department of Law and Governance has sent its proceeding of the meeting held on 21.11.2018 wherein the DRDC had accepted the request of three Ph.D. Students of the Department namely Mr. Arun Kumar, Mr. Rameezur Rahman & Mr. Gautam Kumar to convert their full time Ph.D. programme to part time Ph.D. Programme from the date of application due to their appointments in different Government organizations.

As mentioned in the proceeding of DRDC sent by the Department of Law and Governance the above mentioned three students have taken admission in Ph.D. Programme in February, 2017 as full time Ph.D. candidate. Out of three, one student namely Arun Kumar was in in service of FCI at the time of admission and had been granted study leave for 11 months (w.e.f. 01.08.2017 to 29.06.2018) from his employer for pursuing his Ph.D. programme. Remaining two students Rameezur Rahman and Gautam Kumar got the appointment in Bihar School Examination Board and Bihar Judicial Service respectively while pursuing their Ph.D. Programme.

All the three students had successfully completed their Ph.D. Course Work and continued their Ph.D. programme under the supervision of Ph.D. guide till May, 2018. Consequent upon their appointment these students requested to their DRDC to convert their Ph.D. from full time to part time from May, 2018 which was accepted and approved by the DRDC of Department of Law and Governance in November, 2018.

The UATEC discussed the matter at length and observed that the existing Ph.D. Ordinance is having the provision of part time Ph.D. in consonance with University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degrees) Regulations, 2016 but it is silent on conversion of Ph.D. Programme from full time to part time programme.

The UATEC considered the decision of DRDC in this regard and resolved to recommend to the Academic Council the conversion of Ph.D. from full time to part time in respect of the above three students of Department of Law and Governance with the following conditions-

- 1. Such students will be considered as Part time Ph.D. Scholar from the date of registration in the Ph.D. Programme.
- 2. The minimum duration of completing the Ph.D. programme shall be as specified for part time Ph.D.
- 3. Even as Part time scholar the Ph.D. Students shall be required to submit their progress report as per Ordinance.

The UATEC further decided to add a provision for conversion of Ph.D. from full time to part time and also constituted a three member committee comprising Dr. Alok Kumar Gupta as Convenor and Dr.Pawan Kumar Mishra & Dr. H K Nigam as Member to review the existing Ph.D ordinance and suggest amendments in order to make the ordinance more comprehensive.
