In the wake of MHRD / UGC directive regarding implementation of reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs), a meeting of UATEC was held on **05.07.2019** in the Administrative Building. All the HoDs who are not the member of UATEC were also invited to attend the meeting as special invitees. The meeting was presided by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.

At the outset the Vice - Chancellor welcomed all the members and Head of the Departments who were attending the meeting. The Vice - Chancellor appreciated the contribution of the faculty members in conduct of CUCET-2019 and the first round of admission process thereupon and thanked them for putting their best efforts.

The member secretary briefed the Agenda to be considered in the meeting and the agenda was taken up seriatim.

# Resolution No. 01/UATEC-19/19

As no observations were received on the Minutes of 18<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the UATEC held on 24.06.2019, the UATEC resolved to confirm the Minutes of the 18<sup>th</sup> UATEC meeting.

## Agenda No.02/UATEC-19/19

To consider the MHRD / UGC guideline for increasing the seats under EWSs category and admission in the current Academic Year.

#### Resolution No. 02/UATEC-19/19

The Controller of Examinations apprised the members about the UGC communication F.No. 81-1/2019 (CU) dated 18.01.2019 regarding reservation for Economical Weaker Section for admission in CEIs. whereby the University had been requested to implement the reservation for EWS in admission from the Academic Session -2019-20. The University was also communicated to furnish the programme wise seat matrix after increasing the intake capacity owing to implementation of EWSs reservation. She detailed that as per the provision for reservations for EWSs all the Universities has to increase the number of seats over and above its annual permitted strength in each branch of study / faculty so that the number of seats available, excluding those for reserved for persons belonging to the EWSs, is not less than the number of such seats available, in each category, for the immediately preceding academic session

She further detailed that in pursuance of the above referred MHRD/UGC directive the student's intake of each Department is required to be increased by 1.25 so that after implementation of 10 % EWSs reservation number of seats of other categories are not reduced.

After initial briefing by the Controller of Examinations the Vice-Chancellor outlined the directives of MHRD and UGC and emphasized that the implementation of reservation for EWSs in admission is constitutional obligations hence all the Departments are required to increase the intake capacity of respective programmes offered by them. He further directed the Member Secretary to ensure the reservation for EWSs for admission in all the programmes and to draw the merit list according to the due percentage of each category.

The UATEC resolved to adopt the MHRD Office Memorandum F.No 12-4/2019-U1 dated 17.01.2019 communicated vide UGC letter no. F.No. 81-1/2019 (CU) dated 18.01.2019 and to increase the intake of the existing programmes offered by CU south Bihar as under —
