The Committee discussed about the existing as well as new Programmes to be offered in the Academic Year 2014. After detailed deliberations following decisions were taken:

- All existing UG, PG and Research Programmes will be offered in the Academic Year 2014.
- In the light of MHRD directive to the Central Universities and NCTE and sanction of post by UGC for Education Programme CLB propose to launch MEd Programme from the forthcoming session. Head of Centre for Education was assigned to pursue the matter with NCTE for recognition of the Programme.
