Meeting started with the Vice-Chancellor's brief discussion regarding the preparation for the admission process for the Academic year 2014-15. It was found that some of the Centres/Departments have not submitted the revised details about their programmes, which are to be incorporated in the Prospectus-2014. Such Centres/Departments were asked to submit the same at the earliest so that the compilation work may be completed in time.

The Vice-Chancellor also suggested the concerned Heads/Heads (I/c) of Department/Centre offering Integrated M.Phil.-Ph.D. Programme to prepare a brief write-up about their research programme including the lab equipments and facilities and send it to the Academic Section for inclusion in the Prospectus.

The Vice-Chancellor apprised the members about the MHRD/UGC concern about teacher-student ratio and discussed the possibility to increase the number of seats keeping in view the availability of class room space and lab infrastructure.

After detailed deliberation, it was decided to increase five seats in each of the PG Programmes (excluding M. Tech. & other lab based Programme) and 10 seats in BA.BEd & BA.LLB (Hons.)

It was informed that TCS has been assigned for conducting online test as well as processing of applications for CUBET 2014.
