The process of selection shall be of multiple choice, theory, comprising general knowledge, reasoning, mathematical aptitude and language skill etc. There shall comprise of various domains of knowledge except the discipline related to respective disciplines. Each question carries 1 mark each and the total duration of test will be 1 hour. There would be no negative marking for wrong answers.
