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Meeting started with the appraisal of Vice-Chancellor about groundwork preparation made for CUET 2014. After the opening remarks, he briefed about the purpose of the meeting and agenda was taken up for discussion.

1. The schedule of CUET 2014 was discussed and important dates were finalised. The online / offline application will be available during 28 March - 22 April, 2014. To conduct online examination all over India, 35 examination centres were finalised. Viability of a centre is subject to fulfilment of certain conditions. University reserves the right to merge the non-viable centre(s) with the next nearest viable centre.
2. It was discussed and finalised that online examination (Part-A (55) + PART-B (45)) will be conducted for admission in Integrated UG, PG and MPhil –PhD programmes. The pattern of questions shall be of multiple choices. Part-A comprising general knowledge, reasoning, mathematical aptitude and language skill etc. Part-B shall comprise of various domains of knowledge as per the eligibility criteria in respective discipline. Each question carries 1 (one) mark and the total duration of test will be 2 hrs. There would be no negative marking for wrong answers. After online examination, all applicants shall have to appear in a written test (of 30 marks), followed by interview and/or group discussion (of 20 marks, in total, if required, for assessment of communication skills and general background on scheduled date(s)).
