Resolution No. 05/UATEC-5/6/14	<p>Points were raised about the affiliation of BA BEd & BSc BEd. The Vice-Chancellor conveyed the Committee that matter regarding BEd is being taken by NCTE and it is expected that it will be resolved soon.</p> <p>It is resolved that the admission into BSc BEd & BA BEd shall be continued. Further the intake into BSc BEd/ BSc LLB may be raised to 26 from the present 20 notified seats, in view of the capacity in the existing labs facilities.</p> <p>In case of BA BEd/BA LLB the maximum intake may be 50 each, as against notified 40 seats in each of the programme.</p> <p>It is also resolved that in M.Tech Computer Science, the intake of students is to be increased to 18 as against 15 notified, in view of the latest AICTE guidelines.</p> <p>Instead of 25 seats, intake shall be 26 in all the programmes where it was notified as 25.</p> <p>It is also resolved that scholarship be awarded to the topper of CUBET-2014 admitted in CUB in all programmes.</p> <p>It is also resolved that at the time of admission, written test for 30 (Thirty) marks shall be conducted in all the programmes except UG programmes. If a student has applied for more than one programme, the score obtained by the candidate in the written test of the programme of</p>

	his/her first preference shall be carried to another programme, where he/she has also applied, to attend the interview/group discussion for 20 Marks. In the case of UG all the 50 marks are for interview/group discussion.
