Sixth meeting of the University Admission Teaching and Evaluation Committee (UATEC) was held on **09.02.2015** (Monday) at **CUB, Gaya** campus at 11.00 AM under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Professor Debdas Banerjee to discuss various matters related to evaluation of teaching, the admission of students for session 2015-16, and launching additional programme.

The Vice-Chancellor welcomed all the members of the Committee and especially the special invitees to the meeting. After the opening remarks (he approved the



Minutes of the 5th Meeting of UATEC held on 03.06.2014) the Chair briefed about the purpose of the meeting and the Agenda Items were taken up for discussion.

To begin with, the invited students shared their individual experiences and opinions on teaching and evaluation and other related matters. The salient points of which are :

- 1) All of them expressed their satisfaction about the teaching.
- 2) They feel that the time-schedule for the 'Course Evaluation by the students', at the end of semester teaching, needs to be informed to the students well in-advance. The point is noted for accomplishment.
- 3) Bus facilities are needed from hostel to college campus on Saturdays also, so as to use the Library/Computer lab. For this, the Chair assured that initiatives should be taken immediately.
- 4) Many of the students need additional coaching for proficiency in English language. Ms. Annu Priya, IV sem student of MA English and one of the special invitees has consented to give coaching to the willing students in the Gaya campus. The Heads of Education and the Law programmes, respectively, shall put the tutorial classes in order and Ms. Annu Priya would take up the responsibility of coaching, under the 'Earn while You Learn' scheme.
- 5) It is felt necessary that a Complaint Register be maintained in the Computer lab, for all the computers in the Gaya campus, so that complaints regarding malfunctioning are attended to by the responsible staff at the earliest.
- 6) BSc BEd 2nd semester student pointed out that Animal Science teaching (both theoretical and practical) are neglected, to which Dr. Rizwanul Haque assured to take corrective measures.
- 7) The students voiced that further readings be made available in the library, to which they are suggested to put a demand to the Library for such kinds of books (through concerned HOD/IC), but selectively, since there is not much space available in the stacks to accommodate additional titles.
- 8) Student from Economics has requested for data processing software. For this, initiatives should be made.
- 9) Students also requested for sports goods to make available in the hostels. For this, they were asked to submit a list of such goods to the Warden(s).



Minutes of the Meeting related to admission criteria for Integrated M.Phil-Ph.D.

Minutes of the meeting held on November 20th 2014 at 11:00 AM under the Chairmanship of Prof. Rajmani Prasad Sinha in board room, Central University of Bihar, Patna.

Following members were present:

1. Prof. Rajmani Prasad Sinha, Chairman (Member, Academic Council)
2. Dr. Rizwanul Haque, HoD, Centre for Biological Sciences

Following points were discussed:-

1. As directed by the Academic Council, we discussed the criteria of admission for Technology and Medical graduate students in Research program (Integrated M.Phil-Ph.D.)
2. We thoroughly gone through admission criteria applicable in Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (IISER) Pune, Indian Institute of Technology Bombay etc.
3. We came to the conclusion that Master in Technology (M.Tech.) and Bachelor in Technology (B.Tech.) should not be consider at the same level. So wherever B.Tech. students are eligible for M.Phil-PhD, we have considered a rider for B.Tech. students that they must have a valid GATE score for admission in these course based on the below mentioned criteria.
 - (I) MBBS course runs for four and half years plus one year internship.
 - (II) M.Tech. course runs after four years B.Tech. course.
 - (III) B.Tech. course runs for four years only.
4. We have also seen the prospectus of our university. There itself under eligibility criteria it is given that those having Master degree in relevant subject must have at least 55% marks (or corresponding CGPA) with the stipulated relaxation of 5% for SC/ST candidates. All candidates must have good academic record of 50% marks at both Intermediate and Bachelor levels. We think under these eligibility criteria all aspects have been taken care of.
5. Following eligibility criteria are proposed for admission in Integrated M.Phil-Ph.D. course for technology and MBBS students :-



3.	Integrated M.Phil-Ph.D. in Department of Computer Science	B.Tech. with 55% marks in relevant subject with valid GATE Score / M.Tech. with 55% marks in relevant subject


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4.	Integrated M.Phil-Ph.D. in School of Physical Sciences	B.Tech. with 55% marks in relevant subject with valid GATE Score / M.Tech. with 55% marks in relevant subject
5.	Integrated M.Phil-Ph.D. in Department of Mathematics	B.Tech. with 55% marks in relevant subject with valid GATE Score / M.Tech. with 55% marks in relevant subject
6.	Integrated M.Phil-Ph.D. in Department of Statistics	B.Tech. with 55% marks in relevant subject with valid GATE Score/ M.Tech. with 55% marks in relevant subject
