3	M.A. in English	45	Bachelor's Degree in any discipline having English as a compulsory subject (Hons./ Pass/General) with a minimum of 50% marks for General / OBC/EWS candidates and 45% marks for SC/ST / PWD category candidates from any recognised University.
4	M.A. in Hindi	45	Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from any recognised University with a minimum of 50% marks for General / OBC/EWS candidates and 45% marks for SC/ST / PWD candidates.
5	M.A. in Sociology	45	Bachelor's Degree in any subject from any recognised University with a minimum of 50% marks for General / OBC/EWS candidates and 45% marks for SC/ST / PWD candidates.
6	M.A. in Social Work	45	Bachelor's Degree in any subject from any recognised University with a minimum of 50% marks for General / OBC /EWS candidates and 45% marks for SC/ST / PWD candidates.
