

RESULTS

In estimation of measures of χ^2 fit of the structural model, the chi-square goodness-of-fit test (χ^2) (Bollen, 1989) was $\chi^2(10) = 10.00$, $p < .001$, indicating that with confidence the model represents the population from the χ^2 test of alternative tests (Bollen, 1989) as $\chi^2(10) = 10.00$, $p < .001$, indicating the model is a good fit.
