

However, the most direct and fully-informing source for representation is the form of consensus of the Government as it functions in those bodies who participate in the faculty self-governing, deliberative and decision-making in the University. The details are as given below:

S. No.	Name of Committee	Role and responsibility
1.	Executive Council (EC)	Subject to the provisions of the Act and Statutes, the Executive Council shall exercise governing powers of the University, and exercise control over all the affairs and enterprises of the University and exercise of such powers as are not otherwise specified by the Act. The following are the functions of the EC:- - instituting the faculty as consisting of reporting the same; - in considering the Statutes and the Regulations, and amending or repealing the same; - in having resolutions after having considered the same, made the same permanent, the Regulations and the Statutes and such other matters; - in exercising the powers for the disposal of surplus in the funds, endowments of the University;
2.	Academic Council (AC)	To have complete and complete over the academic affairs of the University and to give the same, reporting matters of importance in connection of teaching among the members, evaluation of research and improvement of academic standards;
3.
