



**NOTICE FOR ADMISSION Ph.D. 2022-2023**

This has reference to the Notification for Admission to Ph.D. Programmes for Academic Year 2022-23 issued vide File No. CUM/Recd/3-3/1912/JC dated 01.09.2022 whereby online applications were invited from NET-JS/ NET-JRF/ GATE etc. qualified candidates for direct admissions to the Ph.D. Programmes.

- The selection procedure for admission to Ph.D. Programmes was defined in para 7 of the said notification which reads as follows:
  - For selection of candidates a weightage of 70% to the score of NET-JS or JRF/ GATE qualifying exam etc. (on 100 point scale) and 30% to the performance in the interview shall be given. Interview of 100 marks shall be conducted of eligible candidates who have applied for through [SUGRA/TS Portal](https://www.sugra.in).
  - The candidate must secure a minimum of 60% marks (30% marks for ICET/CMC/ Puety/ CBSE) in a interview to be eligible for Ph.D. admission in the discipline. However, meeting the said minimum requirement will not guarantee registration for Ph.D. as it is dependent upon performance in the interview and availability of vacant seats.
- In pursuance of the above referred notification, the interviews of candidates for admissions to Ph.D. Programmes were conducted from 10.10.2022 to 20.10.2022.
- During the interview, it transpired that many candidates did not have score/marks of NET/GATE examination while some of them have been awarded with percentile. Resultantly, it was not possible to calculate the 70% weightage of NET/JA/GATE score as prescribed in the selection procedure notified in Admission Notification for Ph.D. Programmes.
- Taking into consideration the above stated facts, the University Admission, Teaching & Evaluation Committee in its 34<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 09.11.2022 decided to draw the merit list of all candidates for admission to Ph.D. Programmes on the basis of interview of 100 marks only, in such subjects wherein the candidates have been awarded with percentile in place of marks / percentage.
- Subsequently, the above recommendation of the UAT/TEC was approved by the Academic Council of the University in its 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 11.11.2022.
- In view of above including, it is hereby notified that in the following Ph.D. Programmes the admission will be made on the basis of interview only, unless the
