



NOTICE FOR ADMISSION Ph.D. 2022-2023

This has reference to the Notification for Admission to Ph.D. Programmes for Academic Year 2022-23 issued vide F.No. 01580/Had/3-3/1922/2022 dated 01.09.2022 whereby online applications were invited from 06.09.2022/ 06.09.2022/ 06.09.2022 onwards, qualified candidates for direct admissions to the Ph.D. Programmes.

1. The selection procedure for admissions to Ph.D. Programmes was defined in para 7 of the said notification which reads as follows:
 - a. For admission of candidates a weightage of 70% to the score of NET (JL or JRF)/GATE qualifying exam etc. (or 60% marks) and 30% to the performance in the interview shall be given. Interview of 100 marks shall be conducted of eligible candidates who have applied for through JAMSRU Portal.
 - b. The candidates must secure a minimum of 6000 marks (600 marks for JL/JRF/NET/GATE/ 60%) in interview to be eligible for Ph.D. admissions in the disciplines. However, meeting the said minimum requirement will not guarantee registration for Ph.D. as it is dependent upon performance in the interview and availability of vacant seats.
2. In pursuance of the above referred notification, the interviews of candidates for admissions to Ph.D. Programmes were conducted from 10.10.2022 to 20.10.2022.
3. During the interview, it transpired that many candidates did not have scores/marks of NET/GATE examination while some of them have been awarded with percentile. Accordingly, it was not possible to calculate the 70% weightage of NET/GATE score as prescribed in the selection procedure specified in Admissions Notification for Ph.D. Programmes.
4. Taking into consideration the above stated facts, the University Admissions, Teaching & Evaluation Committee in its 10th meeting held on 09.11.2022 decided to draw the merit list of all candidates for admissions to Ph.D. Programmes on the basis of interview of 600 marks only, in such subjects wherein the candidates have been awarded with percentile in place of marks / percentage.
5. Subsequently, the above recommendation of the UATC was approved by the Academic Council of the University in its 21st meeting held on 10.11.2022.
6. In view of above fact, it is hereby notified that in the following Ph.D. Programmes the admissions will be made on the basis of interview only, unless the
