

Internal Academic Audit Report

Internal Academic Audit 2022 of all the Academic Departments was scheduled online from Jan 2022 to Feb 2022.

HEIs to conduct self-assessment and internal academic audits to come up with a gap analysis to identify programs that can be converted into a multidisciplinary liberal education framework. The detailed report is as follows:

Department of Hindi

1. The Department has been suggested to develop holistic multiple disciplinary curricula for various programme/courses keeping in mind of multiple entries and multiple exits and Indian Knowledge Systems as required to achieve the target of NEP 2020.
2. ICT-based classes should be conducted/promoted by the faculty in the Dept.
3. More emphasis on developing E-learning materials/content in the light of achieving the target of NEP 2020
4. Innovative pedagogical practices and assessment techniques should be developed by faculty to transform theory into practices ensuring 360-degree assessment of learners.
5. Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) shall be established which would digitally store the academic credits earned.
6. Answer scripts of IA and End Term should be shown to the students for maintaining transparency.
7. Capacity building programme (FDP/RC/OC/Training Program/Workshop) should be conducted as required for National Mission for Mentoring.
8. Student progression and alumni engagement should be developed.
9. Research publication and awards, consultancy, and collaboration for research should be promoted.
10. Interaction with inter-department industry/research centers/educational institutions by the faculty should be encouraged.
11. Publishing of Newsletters/Magazine at Dept level should be promoted.
12. The department should try to initiate not only the faculty exchange programme with national and international bodies even the students and research scholars exchange programme too.
13. Teachers should be encouraged for conducting frontline collaborative research from inter-department and inter-institutions.
14. MoUs should be signed with local/national/international institutions of repute for academic collaboration.
15. Department should start some value-added courses to make students globally employable like public speaking, report writing and creative writing.
16. The Department should try to increase the enrolment in the PG programme.
