

Documents required at the time of interview

1. Bring Five Copies (5%) of a write up on any topic/area of research of your choice with introduction, objective, research methodology and relevance of the subject in 1000 words (approx.).
2. You may have to make a presentation on the topic/area of research submitted by them at the time of interview.
3. On the date of interview, the registered candidate is required to appear in person alongwith -
 - (a) A copy of the filled Application form
 - (b) All required original certificates and one set of photocopy duly attested (Mark sheet and Degree of 10th, 12th, Graduation, Post-Graduation or equivalent showing date of birth/dage).
 - (c) Bring original mark-sheets, certificates, UGC-NET certificate (in case of NET qualified candidate(s)) and other testimonials.
 - (d) Self-attested copy of AADHAR Card, bank account detail of student i.e. (photocopy of first page of the passbook)
 - (e) Character Certificate from the head of the institution last attended.
 - (f) 10 sets of recent passport size photographs.
 - (g) The candidates under reserved category, i.e. OBC (Non Creamy Layer), SC, ST and Divyang shall produce the certificate in the prescribed format issued by a competent authority in support of their claim without which their claim will not be considered.
 - (h) **For SC/ST Candidates** - Attested copy of SC/ST Certificate in the prescribed format of the Govt. of India/ State Govt. issued by an officer not below the rank of Magistrate/Tahsildar in support of their claim for admission against the reserved quota.
 - (i) **For OBC (Non Creamy Layer) Candidates** - OBC Certificate issued by District Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner in the Government of India prescribed format. Also, bring along income certificate. OBC candidates are required to submit the latest OBC certificate in the format prescribed by the Govt. of India.
 - (j) **For EWS Candidates** - The income and assets certificate in the prescribed format issued by
 1. District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner/Additional Deputy Commissioner /First class Stipendiary Magistrate/Sub Divisional Magistrate /Tahsildar/Magistrate Executive Magistrate /Extra Assistant Commissioner.
 2. Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Presidency Magistrate/Presidency Magistrate.
 3. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar and
 4. Sub Divisional Officer or the area where the candidate and/or his family normally resides.
