NEP 2020 Webinar Series, Webinar - No. 1, "Equity and Inclusion"



On the occasion of completion of One Year of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, a Webinar series was organized by different departments of CUSB under the mentorship of Vice-Chancellor Prof. K. N. Singh. The 1st Webinar of the series was organized by the School of Law and Governance of CUSB on the theme "Equity and Inclusion" on July 30, 2021. The key speaker of the webinar was Dr. Pradeep Ramavath J, Associate Professor, TISS, Guwahati. The speaker started his talk with the historical perspective of the theme by mentioning about the struggle of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar. He highlighted the issue of pandemic as a catalyst factor for drop out of students from marginalized communities. It should not only be seen as a medical challenge but the educational challenges as well. He praised the NEP for making a serious attempt to address the issue. At the onset of the webinar Dr. Kumari Neetu, Asst. Prof., Law explained the topic, while Prof. Pawan Kr. Mishra, Head & Dean of SLG, Dr. P.K. Das, Associate Prof., SLG, Prof. S.P. Srivastava also spoke on the theme. Dr. Anant Prakash Narayan, Asst.Prof, SLG was the Coordinator of the event.

NEP 2020 Webinar No. 2, Webinar No. 2, "Multidisciplinary and Holistic Education" – 02nd August

The second webinar of the series was organized by School of Social Sciences and Policy (SSSP), on the theme "NEP 2020 and Multidisciplinary, Holistic Education" on August 02, 2021. The keynote address was delivered by Dr. Manisha Priyam, Professor of Educational Policy Reforms at NIEPA, Delhi, who argued that New multidisciplinary education has a rich heritage both within the country and abroad. She cited the example of global institutions like LSE in the UK and the newly upcoming universities in the country that try to blend liberal arts and engineering education. Dr. Priyam, also argued that the need of the hour is to find out ways in which public universities in the country take the lead in this novel mission of the NEP 2020.



Dr. Aditya Mohanty, Asst. Prof., DVS and the Coordinator of the Event argued that multidisciplinary approach is crucial in these times to improve India's contribution in the Global Research Output, which stands at a dismal 3 per cent! Finally, the event came to an end with the Dean, SSSP, Prof Krishnan Chalil, who in his concluding remarks argued that multidisciplinary approach required changes in the very curriculum design of existing mainstream courses.

NEP 2020 Webinar Series, Webinar No. 3, "Skill, Entrepreneurship"



The third webinar of the series was organized by School of Management on August 03, 2021. The Dept. of Commerce and Business Studies organised the webinar on the topic "Skill, Entrepreneurship Development and Employability: Challenges and Opportunities". Eminent Speaker Prof. Ranjit Singh, Indian Institute of Information Technology, Allahabad delivered the keynote address on the topic. He started his talk with the conceptual background of entrepreneurship and moved towards the different entrepreneurial model and discussed how idea generation is the root cause for any entrepreneurial venture. He talked about the creative destruction i.e., until old is destroyed new cannot be created. The speaker highlighted nudging which means incentivizing the entrepreneurship, exposure theory, compulsion and setting up of incubators for facilitating entrepreneurial potentials. Prof. Brajesh Kumar, Head and Dean also shared his opinion on the theme. The webinar was co-ordinated by Ms. Renu, Asst. Prof. & vote of thanks was proposed by Dr. Subramanian Shanmugam, Associate Prof. of the department.

The eighth and last webinar of the series was jointly organised conducted by School of EBES and Department of Computer Science on August 10, 2021 on "Use of Technology in Education".




Webinar on Indian Olympic Journey-a Way to TOPS, 05th Oct

A Plenary lecture on 99th Birth anniversary of Prof. G.N. Ramachandran was organised by the dept. of Bioinformatics of CUSB on October 8, 2021. Prof. Ashok Kolaskar, a wellknown Bioinformatics scientist in the country and former VC of University of Pune and KIIT, Bhubaneshwar delivered the lecture on Prof. Ramachandran. Speaking on this occasion Prof. Ashok Kolaskar, who worked with G.N. Ramachandran during the 1970s gave a detailed account of his life and work. Prof. Kolaskar said GNR is known for his contribution on the discovery of the triple helical structure of fibrous protein collagen in 1954, and developing a twodimensional map in 1963, popularly called as Ramachandran map. This map was a major breakthrough in the growth of molecular biology and till today it serves as an important tool to understand protein structure, conformation, and to build protein models. In his presidential remark CUSB VC Prof. K.N. Singh elaborated about the works of G.N. Ramachandran and said his work is the pride of Indian Science.




CUSB team second runner-up in National Moot Court Competition
