एनएसएस का ओरिएंटेशन कार्यक्रम, 16 फरवरी 2022

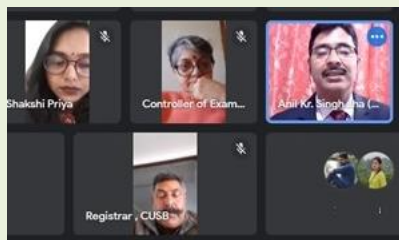

Moot Court Workshop, 23rd - 24th June, 2022

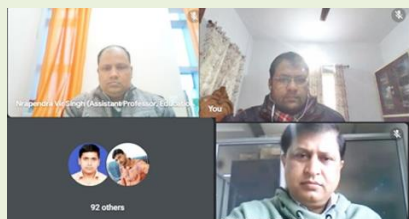

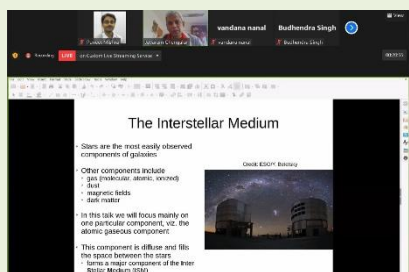

Capacity Building Training on Innovation & Entrepreneurship, 27-28 January, 2022



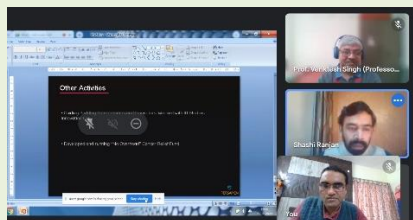

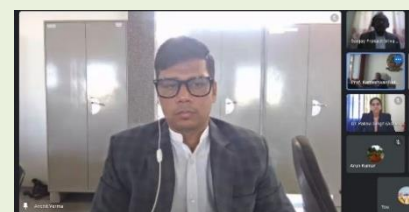
Webinar on 'Computer Viruses and Spyware: Threats and Prevention'

पंडित दीनदयाल उपाध्याय की पुण्यतिथि पर श्रद्धांजलि सह विचार संगोष्ठी



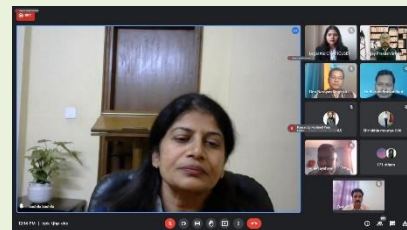

Webinar on “Challenges in Effective Implementation of Consumer Laws” 25-26 February, 2022



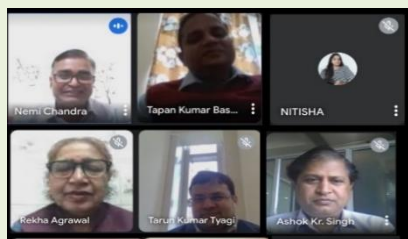

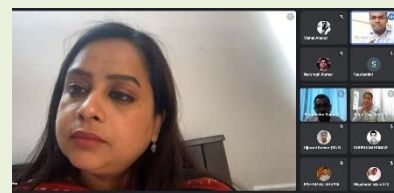
Public Lecture on Issues and Challenges of Social Security in Unorganised Sector, 29th March



The School of Law and Governance (SLG) of CUSB organized the second lecture under the public lecture series to celebrate and commemorate "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav". The key speaker Prof. Suresh Chandra Srivastava, Secretary General, National Labour Law Association, New Delhi put forth the plight of unorganized workers in India which constitutes a total 86 percent of total workforce. He further assimilated that workers are the most neglected and exploited class. There are in toto 38 central legislations and more that 100 state legislations to uphold the interest of the workers but there subsists lack of awareness and implementation. Five-day training programme on Disaster Risk Management, 23-27 May, 2022



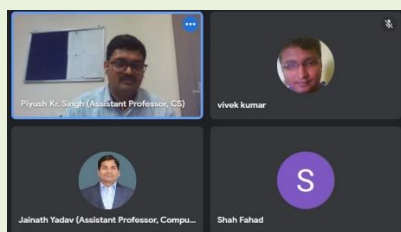

Guest Lecture on "How to write after all?", 10th June, 2022



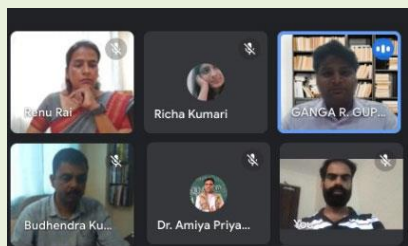

सीयूसबी में मनाया गया आदिवासियों का पर्व सरहुल

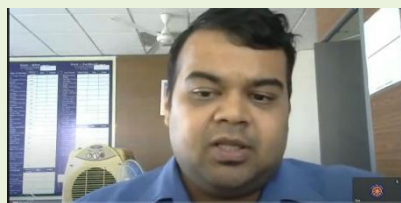

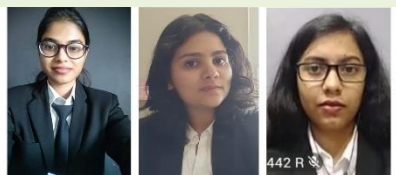

More than 200 students from different departments of CUSB have qualified for UGC NET / Lecturership & JRF Exam conducted by the NTA (National Examination Agency) for December 2020 and June 2021.
