In view of the agenda of the meeting the Board has arrived at the following decisions:

- The Board has approved the course Structure and detailed Syllabi of M.A. History Programme which
 is attached herewith as annexure I.
- II. For different Semesters of this programme, the course has been divided into three parts as: core courses, elective courses and skill based Non Credit courses.
- III. These courses are structured in such a manner that the altogether fourteen core courses and ten elective courses are available to the students.
- IV. The choice of the students to avail the elective courses from other Departments or Schools will be guided by the ordinance of the Department.
- V. In each semester minimum six Courses comprising of core and elective will be offered. The details thereof is attached herewith in the annexure 1.
- VI. Given the nature of the discipline some of the courses are divided into three groups viz (A) Ancient History (B) Medieval History (C) Modern History. Students shall have to opt only one group throughout the programme

In view of the present faculty strength the Board has suggested the department to offer only Group C i.e. Modern History.

The meeting of the Board of Studies ended by expressing its thanks to the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Central University of south Bihar for launching M.A. Programme in History.
