

Hostel allotment Rules for Research Scholar (Ph.D.)

In the light of the Rules & Regulations Governing Hostel Administration and Residency Ordinance Clause number 2.4.13 (i), the norms, procedure and conditions of the admission at the CUSIB Hostel for Ph.D. Students will be as follows:

2.4.13 (i)

- A) The Ph.D. students will be allotted the hostel accommodation only for period of maximum three years which will be their residency period decided by the existing Ph.D. Ordinances, CUSIB, Gays.
- B) The Ph.D. students will be required to deposit Rs. 15000/- per semester as Hostel fee, Rs. 3000/- as Security money and Rs. 1000/- for Hostel maintenance Charge (Annually). So total 19000/-expn. The BDF students can obtain their hostel fee receipt certified by the Registrar for the reimbursement as per the UGC HRA Rule, after the payment of their Hostel fee.
- C) The Ph.D. students will required to submit their application form for hostel accommodation with the forward of the concerned supervisor and the DRDC Chairperson. The concerned DRDC chairperson is supposed to forward the application only according to the number of seats allotted to the concerned Department.
- D) The Eligibility Criteria: The merit of the applicants will be decided on the basis of the average of overall percentage of obtained marks at 10th, 12th, UG and PG examination. Reservation policy in allotment of rooms will be applied as per government rules and regulations. However, the available rooms are very limited so the hostel administration decisions in this regards will be treated as final.
- E) Mess facility will be provided only when it is open.
- F) The Ph.D. Students admitted to the CUSIB hostel are required to deposit hostel fee within the stipulated time decided by the University, failing which, they will have to vacate the hostel within three days.
- G) Admitted Ph.D. students are required to strictly follow the code of conduct and the discipline given in the hostel manual.
