Subject: Building an avenue for Common University Entrance Test (CUET) (PGU)-2023 Examination among existing candidates – 10g.

The Common University Entrance Test (PGU) – 2023 is scheduled to be held in the month of June 2023 across India for providing admission in any of the Central Universities (CUs) or other participating organisations (including State Universities, Deemed and Private Universities) across the Country. At present approximately 961 Universities/ Institutions / Organisations / Autonomous Colleges are participating in CUET (PGU) – 2023.
