The details regarding qualifications, experience and indicative proformas etc. are available on the University website along with this advertisement. The applicants are required to read these details carefully before filling up the application form.
2.	Applicants should possess the prescribed qualifications and experience as on the closing date of application, as prescribed by the University from time to time for the respective posts.
3.	Applicants are advised to check the University website regularly. The university will not be responsible for invalid/wrong email address and Mobile No., etc. mentioned by the applicants in their online application form. 19.	The University reserves the right to relax any of the qualifications, experience, etc., in deserving cases in respect of any post. Candidates shall not claim it as a right.
20.	The number of vacancies of the posts indicated in this Employment Notification is tentative. The University reserves the right to fill any consequential vacancies, and /or to increase/decrease the number of posts and make appointments accordingly.
21.	The Shortlisted candidates called for interview should report along with all the testimonials/certificates in original along with valid photo ID (Aadhaar/Voter Id/Driving License/Passport). A set of online filled application form and self-attested photocopy of certificates/testimonials with respect to the qualifications, experience and category as applicable, indicated in the online application form, duly certified by the applicant should be submitted at the time of interview.
