

Applications to the graduate program are limited through online study form by August 15th, 2016. Students that do not submit an application by 08/15/2016, regardless of their AP coursework progress, for the online review 08/15/16.

1. Applicants must be ready, on the basis of work that is already done, to enroll through **Graduate Applied Science/Healthcare** (N.C. Central College) or the National Testing Agency (NTA) through NTA Regional Center for Healthcare (N.C. Central College) in the next fall.

2. Eligibility Criteria for admission :

Bachelor's degree in **Biochemistry** or any branch of Biological Science (Microbiology/ Biochemistry/ Molecular/ Environmental Science/ Biomedical) and an GRE General Test Score (Science/Chemistry) is 280+ (unweighted) is held, all other requirements will pay of the test subject among Biology, Science & Chemistry in the next with a minimum of 60% marks for Computer & Math (N.C. Central College) and 60% marks for GRE/NTA conditions from any recognized university.
