Essential qualifications	- M.Sc. with minimum 50% marks (or equal Grade Point) in Environmental Science. - Candidates should have qualified National Level Exam, such as UGC-NET/JRF, GATE in the relevant subject. - If candidate has not qualified National level examination as mentioned in above point 2, will be given post in Junior Project Fellow (JPF).
Desirable qualifications	Candidates with experience of Field survey, House survey, Data collection, Quantitative based survey of Toxic economic, health etc. will be given priority.
Age limit	34 years on the date of application, with education up to B.Sc./B.Com./B.A. women candidates as per Government of India norms.
Duration	Initial appointment will be for one year, which is extendable up to the 4 years subject to good performance after completion of each year.
Salary considerations	JRF Rs. 31,000 + HRA per month for JRF (initial two years) and 15000+ HRA per month for JRF (third year and so on) JPF Rs. 25,000 + HRA per month for JPF (initial two years) and 18000+ HRA per month for JPF (third year and so on)

Undertaking rigorous field visits and surveys, House survey, Data collection, Quantitative based survey of Toxic economic and health data, Sampling and analysis of Indoor and ambient air and environmental samples.
