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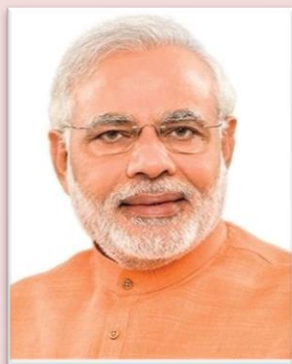
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# From the Desk of Vice-Chancellor

## Major Achievements / Executive Summary

### CUSB signed a MoU with VV Biotech Pvt. Ltd., 10th December

Taking an initiative towards adopting the National Education Policy (NEP) – 2020 in its curriculum and Drug Discovery CUSB signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Vastu Bihar Biotech Private Limited on December 10, 2021. The Inter Institutional – Industry Partnership was signed between CUSB VC Prof. K.N. Singh and Mr. Vinay Kumar Tiwary, Chief Managing Director (CMD) Sambodhi Retreat, Bodhgaya. The Controller of Examination (CoE) Mrs. Rashmi Tripathi as the Registrar (In-charge) also signed the collaboration document in presence of CUSB Biotech department former head, Prof. Rizwanul Haque who played an instrumental role in making the academia – industry partnership possible. On this occasion Biotech department head Prof. Durg Vijai Singh, Dr. Rakesh Kumar, Dr. Jawaid Ahsan, Dr. Krishna Prakash, IQAC Chairman Prof. Venkatesh Singh, Proctor Prof. Umesh Kumar Singh were present along with heads, faculty members, University officers, research scholars and students of the departments. The officials and research scholars working at Vastu Vihar Biotech Pvt. Ltd. were also present in the MoU signing ceremony.



### National Level District Green Champion Award to CUSB:

CUSB was selected by the Government of India for the 'District Green Champion Award 2021-22' for its clean and green campus. ## Central University of South Bihar at a Glance

### About the University

The Central University of South Bihar shortly termed as CUSB is established under the Central Universities Act, 2009 (section 25 of 2009) as Central University of Bihar (name changed under the Central Universities Amendment Act, 2014). The University is functioning from the 300 acres sprawling campus at Panchanpur, about 15kms. from Gaya Railway Station, on Gaya – Panchanpur Road (National Highway No. 07). The University is accredited with 'A' Grade by the NAAC and succeeded in achieving 94th position in NIRF Ranking in the year 2016. With the combined efforts of the University fraternity and its stake-holders, CUSB has maintained its excellence in Academia and achieved a respectable position in the rankings carried out by different government and private agencies. The University welcomes visitors with a grand Entrance Plaza and further provides visual delight with a half-globe shaped Stupa and a magnificent multi-storied Administrative Block building. Besides, three massive Schools buildings namely (i) School of Earth, Biological and Environmental Sciences named as Aryabhatta Bhawan, (ii) School of Social Sciences and Policy named as Chanakya Bhawan and (iii) School of Education building named as Malaviya Bhawan, and other buildings namely, Vivekanand Lecture Complex, Sangharam Guest House, Gargi Sadan Boys Hostel and Maitreyi Sadan Girls Hostel altogether are like visual treat for visitors, and offering a pristine environs for running academic and co-curricular activities. Along with world-class highly qualified faculty members, high teacher-student ratio, baskets full of elective courses in different programmes, the University offers Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) with total internal evaluation of students' performance at Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) levels. Other highlights of CUSB includes a conducive and research-oriented environment with multidisciplinary approach, innovative pedagogies, promising infrastructural facilities and effective students' support system to nurture students' personality in a holistic manner and to prepare them for a bright future. The University is fully committed to adopt the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 in its curriculum in the upcoming academic session.

## Facilities at CUSB

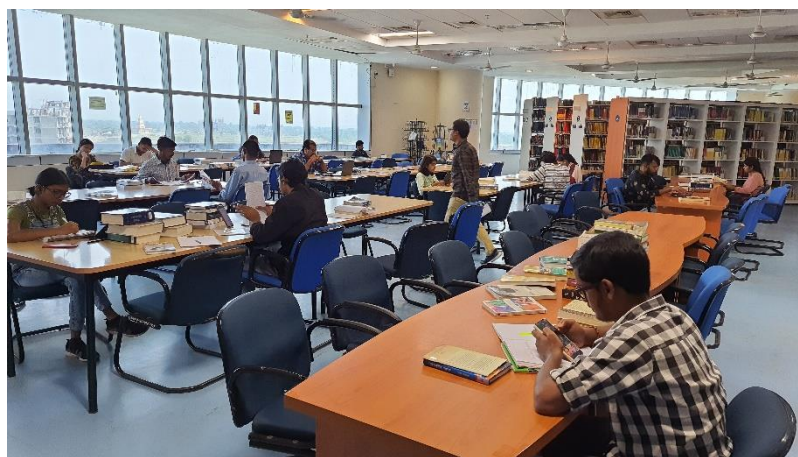
The University puts its best efforts to offer a passable atmosphere for learning and high-quality research activities to the students and faculty members. The well-stocked library, computer centres with contemporary facilities like Wi-Fi, state-of-the-art laboratories with delicate to heavy equipments, smart class rooms, conference rooms, playground, etc. altogether makes the University a perfect abode for academia and impress the outside world a lot and helps in earning plaudits in the form of Rankings carried out by different agencies of the country.

### Central Computing Facility (University Computer Centre)

The Central Computing facility is offered with sufficient numbers of desktops / laptops attached with printer / Xerox facilities at almost all work desks. The Computer Laboratory provides a central computing facility to the faculty members, researchers as well as students for their assignments, projects, dissertation and research related works. In Computer Lab, printing and scanning facilities are also available. Teachers are also provided with individual desktop / laptop with pool printer to assist them in preparing for their lectures and take up their research pursuits. All computers are equipped with latest and legal operating system and application software to cater to the academic needs. Computers are protected by firewall and reliable antivirus software against computer virus, malware and unauthorized access. Internet facility through LAN as well as Wi-Fi connectivity is provided to departments /centres, library, class rooms, administrative building and other sections. The University has powerful E-mail system with group mail IDs of students, faculty members and staff.

### University Library

The University has a well-stocked Central Library with good collection of Title of latest edition of books in sufficient volumes, standard national and international journals. The library has more than 41,000 books to support academic curricula, teaching & research in various science and social science subjects. All the books are barcoded and organized on shelves using Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC) scheme. The library subscribes to 181 print journals and magazines. The library is stocked with 444 bound volumes of journals and



100 project reports and more than 8200 full text electronic (e) journals from renowned publishers. Library services include circulation (issue/return) of books, Inter-Library Loan through DELNET, New Delhi, Current Awareness Service (CAS) for books and journals, photocopy, etc. Users can search the availability of books in library using OPAC, current status of books, due date of return, reserve/hold book, etc. Access to electronic resources is available for students, faculty and officials on their computer within the university premises. Recently, access to these resources has been extended through Virtual Private Network (VPN). 24 x 7 reference service is also being provided through CUSB Virtual Reference Platform.



## Laboratories

Most of the departments have its own laboratory equipped with equipment and latest instruments for conducting practicals of students and research scholars. The departments of Biotechnology, Geology, Pharmacy, Life Science, Environmental Science, Physics, Chemistry, Mass Communication, etc. have well – furnished laboratories.

## Health Centre / Medical Facility

The University has its Health Centre, which provides primary level treatment to faculty, staff and students for general ailments under the supervision of Medical officer.

## Psychological Counselling Service

Like physical health, mental health determines efficiency and productivity, which is critically important for teaching-learning process, creativity, and congenial environment in academic institutions. The University adopts a forward looking approach and institutes psychological counselling and guidance for students, faculty and employees under the supervision of expert time-to-time or on need basis.

## Exclusive Facilities for Students

The University believes that the students are future of the country and they deserve extra care to pursue their studies without any hassle. The University is committed to offer the best possible amenities to students so that they can study and carry on research work with complete peace of mind for a better outcome. Some of the facilities specifically provided to students are mentioned below under separate heads:

**Semester System:** The Semester System is followed in all Academic programmes (courses) of the University to enhance the curricular space and encourage the accelerated learning opportunities.

**Choice Based Credit System (CBCS):** The CBCS System facilitates the students to have vertical integration of knowledge and holistic development.

**Evaluation System:** Continuous internal evaluation is carried out in the University by the faculty members to assess the performance of the students. The University has developed appropriate mechanism to ensure transparency and accountability in the internal assessments and End-Semester evaluations.

**Governance & E-Governance:** The University is following a decentralised and participative system of governance to achieve the mandate stated in the Act and Statues. Faculty members are directly involved in decision-making bodies of the University, which in turn helps the students in a great way for redressal of their grievances. Each department of the University has a Departmental Committee and it takes the decisions for academic proposals at initial state before being placed before Apex decision-making bodies of the University. The Board of Studies (BOS) is also an important body of the department which specifically looks after the curriculum development work. Also, the University has put its efforts towards the use of E-Governance tools to bring effectiveness into its administration to promote transparency and efficiency in the system.

**Admission through CUCET:** The Admission to various programmes (courses) of the University is made through national level entrance test jointly conducted for over a dozen Central Universities called Central Universities Common Entrance Test (CUCET). With its transparent and national level admission process, the University has succeeded to attract the students from different states and maintaining the diversity & national character efficiently.

**Scholarship Schemes:** All research scholars (Ph.D.) students get UGC scholarship. In addition to Centre government and state government funded scholarships, the University offers a number of scholarship schemes to deserving and needy students, namely (i) Merit Scholarship to CUCET / Semester Toppers (ii) Merit-cum-Means Scholarship (iii) Earn While You Learn (EWYL) Scheme & (iv) Attendance Based Merit Scholarship.

**Vidyarthi Mediclaim Policy:** All the students of the University are insured under this scheme. This is a unique policy of National Insurance Company (NIC) designed to provide health and personal accident cover to the students. Under this scheme the students are eligible for cashless treatment in authorized hospitals as well as for reimbursement of cost of treatment in other hospitals within the limit of Rs. 50,000.

**Boys & Girls Hostels for Accommodations:** Presently the University offers accommodation to students with one (1) Boys Hostel and one (1) Girls Hostel having combined capacity to accommodate around 800 students. Mess facility is also available for students residing in the hostels on payment basis.



**Sports & Co-curricular Activities:** The University has a huge sports complex named as 'Milkha Singh Sports Complex' where various sports activities are conducted for students round the year. Usually the sports activities are conducted by the Games and Sports Activities Committee. The students of the

University participate in the state and nation level competitions and events under the supervision of co-ordinators of the committees and win many competitions with their brilliant performances.

**Internships:** Keeping in view the importance of role of practice-based learning / first-hand industry experience the University use to make arrangements for internship opportunities to the students during Summer vacation.

**Campus Placements:** The University has a Career Counselling and Placement Cell which takes care of the campus placements and job opportunities for the students. Many students got job placement during the session 2020-21 in organisations like Azim Premji Foundation, Care India (NGO), Gandhi Fellowship - Piramal Foundation, etc. Students from Media department got placements in Times of India, Hindustan Times, ETV Bharat, Hindustan Dainik and Prabhat Khabar and along with many other organisations.

**Quality Management through IQAC:** The University is having an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) to ensure progressive improvement in efficiency of the functioning of the institution.

**Proctorial Board:** The board is responsible to maintain discipline among the students of University and it functions under supervision of the Chief Proctor. The Proctorial board takes preventive steps to maintain the discipline within the University premises, issues the notices and warnings as per need of the situation.

**Dean Students' Welfare:** The Dean Students' Welfare (DSW) is shouldering the responsibility of looking after the general welfare of students outside classrooms, in order to ensure all round development. The office of DSW also performs the duties and functions viz. (i) make arrangements for educational tours, excursions and participation in sports activities outside the University (ii) conduct social and cultural activities (iii) form of student bodies (iv) evaluate student – teacher relationship (v) examine and recommend for financial aid to needy students and concession for travel, and other facilities (vi) facilitate fellowships / scholarships for further studies in the country or abroad (vii) student counselling (viii) provide special assistance (if required) to differently abled students or women students (ix) provide Student information services (x) organise alumni association (xii) issue certificates as authorised and delegated by the Vice-Chancellor.

### बाबू जगजीवन राम जयंती, 5 अप्रैल 2021



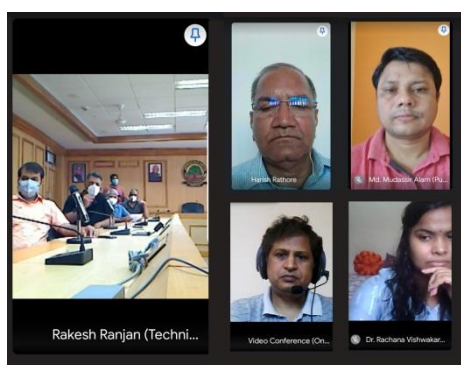

### Anti-Tobacco Pledge, 31st May, 2021

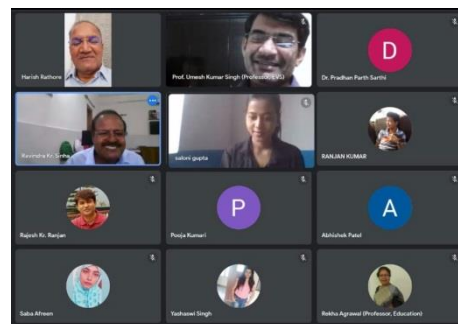

### International Human Rights Day, 10th December, 2021

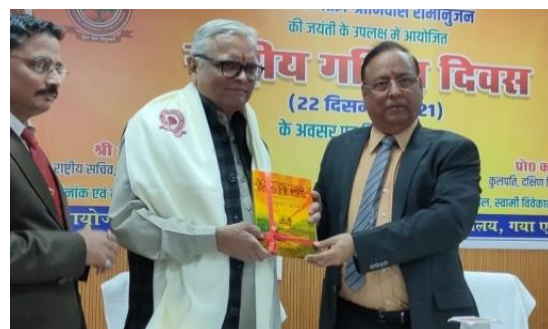

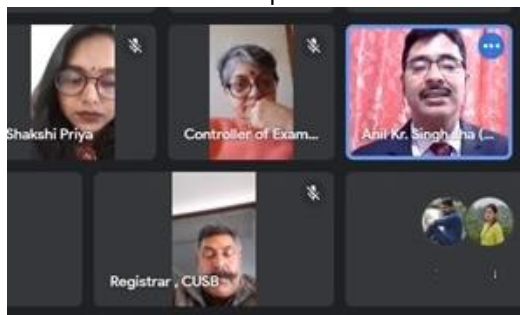
### Republic Day Celebration, 26<sup>th</sup> January, 2022
