Subject: Awarding Ph.D. degree Certificates to candidates successfully completed viva-voce in compliance to UGC Regulations - Reg. ...

Incidences of reported delays in awarding Ph.D. degree to candidates who have successfully completed viva-voce have been brought to the notice of UGC. In this regard, the relevant provisions of UGC Regulations are mentioned as under:-

 UGC notified and published the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Awards of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2016 in the Gazette of India on 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2016 and therein clause 9.9 states as under:

"The Institutions shall develop appropriate methods so as to complete the entire process of evaluation of M.Phil. dissertation/Ph.D. thesis within a period of six months from the date of submission of the dissertation/thesis".

2. Further, UGC has also notified the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Awards of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations 2022 in the Gazette of India on 7<sup>th</sup> November, 2022 wherein under clause 11 (Evaluation and Assessment Methods, minimum standards/credits for award of the degree, etc.) sub point No.7 states as under:

"The Higher Educational Institution concerned shall complete the entire process of evaluating a Ph.D. thesis, including the declaration of the viva-voce result, within a period of six (6) months from the date of submission of the thesis".

All the Universities are requested to comply with above mentioned provisions of UGC Regulations.
